The show brings together a stellar line-up of studio woodturners from seven countries. By its very nature, woodturning requires artists to work in harmony with what artist David Ellsworth describes as "nature's most perfect imperfect material." The challenge to this year's artists was to come to their own interpretation of harmony, and to express it through sculpture.
