50TH ANNIVERSARY OF WOMEN'S ADVOCATES



We've collaborated with Women's Advocates to present *Voices* of Change: 50 Years of Hope and Healing, an exhibit featuring works by artists dedicated to breaking the cycle of domestic violence, as well as pieces created by victim-survivors themselves. This powerful exhibit commemorates the 50th anniversary of Women's Advocates as the nation's first shelter for victim-survivors of domestic violence.

In recognition of October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month and the 30th anniversary of the Violence Against Women Act, Senator Amy Klobuchar held a press conference in the gallery to reaffirm her commitment to supporting survivors.
